**Subject: Death of Fr. Pedro Llabrés, TOR,
of the Province of the Immaculate Conception, Spain.**

On the morning of January 2, 2005, our brother

FR. PEDRO LLABRÉS FERRER, TOR

died at the friary of the Collegio Raimundo Lulio in Madrid. Fr. Pedro was born in Inca, Mallorca, on April 24, 1932. He was the son of Miguel Llabrés Mulet (+1975) and Margarita Ferrer Servera (+1983) and was the oldest of three children (Pedro, Juan, and Magdalena).

Fr. Pedro received the TOR habit on August 10, 1947. After his novitiate year in Artá he professed Simple Vows on August 12, 1948, and professed Solemn Vows on August 12, 1954 at the Porciúncula. Pedro studied humanities at the Porciúncula, philosophy at Inca, and completed his theological studies in Rome. He was ordained to the priesthood on March 17, 1956, in Palma di Maiorca by Bishop Jesús Enciso Viana, the Bishop of Maiorca.

After his ordination in 1956 Fr. Pedro was assigned to Quintanar dell'Ordine in Toledo. During the time this friary housed the Seraphic Seminary Fr. Pedro served as director of the seminarians. When the seminary was transferred to Ntra. Sig.ra. di Vico (Arnedo, La Rioja) Fr. Pedro remained in Quintanar as a teacher. He also was the organist and choir director for the friary church.

Fr. Pedro was assigned to the friary of San Bonaventura in Lluçmajor in 1964 where he worked at the school. In addition to his teaching, during the 13 years in which he lived at Lluçmajor he also served as local economer, administrator of the friary and school (1964 - 73), and organist and choir director for the friary church (1973-77).

After the Provincial Chapter of 1977 Fr. Pedro was transferred to Madrid where he served as the administrator of the Collegio Raimundo Lulio. He was also chosen as a member of the economic commission of province.

Fr. Pedro was elected as a member of the Provincial Council in 1983 and was appointed as the administrator of the province. He maintained these responsibilities until 1989. During the Provincial Chapter of 1989 he was reconfirmed as the administrator of the Collegio Raimundo Lulio, a position he held until his death.

Among his other assignments, Fr. Pedro also served as a parochial vicar in our Church of St. Diego in Madrid from 1988 - and from 1993 to his death he was a member of the Provincial Council for Economic Affairs.

For approximately 17 years Fr. Pedro suffered with a poor heart. He underwent surgery for this condition two times - and as a result of complications he has had to have dialysis treatments for the past two years.

Our brother Pedro was 72 years old at his death. He was a TOR religious for 56 years and served as a priest for 48 years.

May he sleep in the peace of the Lord.
